Mission 4: Creativity for Change!

In *The Trash Travelers* board game, the goal is to prevent trash from entering the ocean. But there is a twist: you cannot win by just cleaning. To succeed, you must also create art pieces and discuss root cause solutions.

Why? Because The Trash Traveler's main phrase is: "It's not about cleaning."

If we only clean and never address the causes, we are like someone trying to empty a bathtub with a spoon while the tap is still running. The real challenge is not just removing trash, but stopping it from being produced in the first place. This game is about raising awareness. Through creativity, we can inspire communities, spark conversations, and make people think beyond the clean-up.

That is why **Mission 4** is about using art as a storytelling tool. **Storytelling** is the art of sharing ideas, values, and emotions in a way that connects deeply with people. It transforms facts into experiences and inspires action. By telling stories through art, we make environmental issues relatable, urgent, and impossible to ignore.

Your task to accomplish the mission:

- **Either** reuse some trash to create an art piece it can be a 2D or 3D artwork;
- **or** make a drawing on old paper about saving the ocean or any environmental theme;
- **or** surprise us with your creativity in any different way.
